Public Participation:

Potholes throughout village have been reported. Cllr Wells is also pushing this with NLC. Brown bins have only been collected once this year down Clarkes Road (this is a different collection with smaller vehicle to the rest of the village with the road being a dead-end); this has been reported.

Cllrs were asked to feedback on the Data Centre presentation: it was voiced that it was a good presentation on what they were going to do there and they had clearly done their research regarding the land and historic issues / cables etc and would be of benefit to the area.

2404/4 To receive any reports from external organisations
a) PRAX – traffic volume has been addressed and expectations of work force have been reiterated. The contracts manager is on board with this and is also reinforcing expectations. Signage is being kept up to date. The schedule is going well with limited slippage time.

Cllr Broddley reported the traffic statistics which had previously been sent to PRAX: 2nd April 2024 17.55 until 18.10.

The number of vehicles that came through the village was 56.

35 weren't speeding at the point where the speed sign is located, 16 were speeding with a maximum speed observed of 40mph. Only 4 of the vehicles were vans, the rest were cars.

It was good to see that most of the vehicles were multiple occupancy so lots of car sharing going on.

156 vehicles in that time, 31 speeding at the point of the speed sign.
Two vehicles were doing in excess of 47mph – reg numbers were recorded
Two other registrations were going in excess of 40mph – reg numbers were recorded

6 month trial. Concerns were raised about no safe place to get off the bus

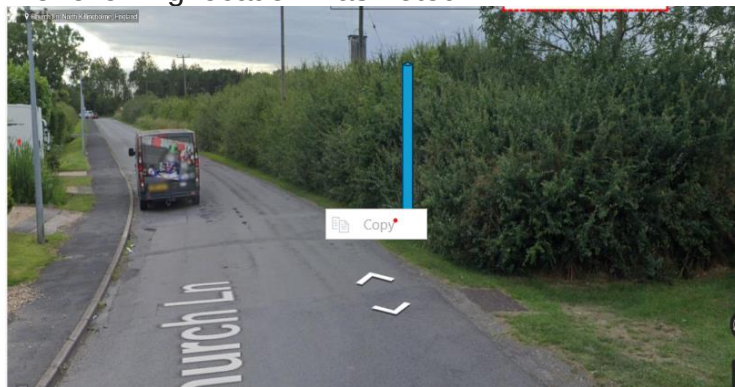
