Greystoke Land Presentation

Plans for UK's first AI data centre in South Killingholme being the first Humber and UK AI centre – Humber Tech Park set in 200 acres. 2.2 – 3bn of foreign direct investment creating 3000 jobs a year in the construction phase and 370 well-paid (50k plus) full time jobs and higher salaries for specialist skills as well as security jobs, cleaning, maintenance, catering.

There is a significant potential to contribute to education, training and infrastructure with 10 million 106 contribution. This could be used to extend the GP surgery, improve the village hall, heat Immingham swimming pool and subsidise a bus service.
